## COVID HANDBOOK

### DOWN SYNDROME 2022

19<sup>th</sup> – 26<sup>th</sup> June 2022, Nymburk, Mladá Boleslav, Czech Republic

#### **GENERAL INFORMATION**

The disease caused by the Covid-19 virus is currently perceived as a common respiratory disease in the Czech Republic, because in the vast majority of cases, the recovery takes place without any difficult course or complications.

The vaccination rate of the population by the 2nd dose is 64 %, and the booster dose is 38 %.

Therefore, respiratory protection is voluntary throughout the country, so in most cases, there is no confirmation about the vaccination or illness required, with just one exception of this rule in public transport and visits to medical, senior or social facilities.

Thus, only FFP 2 respirators or Nano drapes are considered adequate respiratory protection.

#### **BEFORE ARRIVAL**

The continuously updated conditions for entry to the Czech Republic from a specific country are currently determined by a colour traffic light by the Ministry of Health of the Czech Republic. All the information for the arrival of individual expeditions to our country can be found at : [List of countries according to the level of risk – Current information about COVID-19 \(mzcr.cz\)](#). At the moment, all the foreign who enter the Czech Republic (regardless of the degree of risk/colour ) are obliged to fill so called “Arrival Form”.

#### **COURSE OF THE WORLD CHAMPIONSHIP: ACCOMMODATION, CATERING, SPORTS FACILITIES**

Wearing of respiratory protection during the whole course of World Championship SU-DS is voluntary, including sports facilities, a regeneration area, a or even a bar and during the social event and the way to get there. Depending on the current situation, the room, common and social rooms or sports facilities may be equipped with disinfectants, especially for hand hygiene.

## **IF SUSPECTED SYMPTOMS OCCURE**

An antigen test can be used for a fast, initial diagnosis and is available at organisers. Confirmation of the infection must be performed by a PCR at a designated test site (or in a medical facility). In case, the infection is confirmed by the PCR test, the organizers will ensure an isolation for the infected person including his/her diet, and will inform the locally competent hygienic station in the town Nymburk. In case, that is a larger number of people are infected, the hygienic station will decide on further action within the World Championship. At the moment the ordered isolation period in the Czech Republic is seven days, however, even in this case the hygienist can decide to change the time and a method of isolation due to a asymptomatic course of the disease.

Both in the area of Nymburk Sports Centre as well as the stadium in Mladá Boleslav, medical first aid will be provided on sites, with the possibility of a transport to a medical facility. LOC appoints a COVID Manager of the World Championship SU-DS.
